Eligibility :

Category A:

Project Scientist:

Master's Degree in Anthropology or allied discipline of a Recognized University/institute having Ph.D. or five years Research experience with evidence of Research in Anthropology. Publications in impact journals preferred. Age limit 65 years.

Category B :

Project Research Associate :

Master's Degree in Anthropology or allied discipline with desirable supporting Ph.D. or three years experience as evidence of contribution in Anthropology. Fieldwork experience desirable. Age limit 40 years.

Project Assistant Librarian :

B. Lib with I.T. knowledge and three years experience in a Reputed Library. Age limit 40 years.

Category C :

Project Research Assistant : Master's Degree in Anthropology or allied discipline, preference will be given to the candidates having fieldwork experience. Computer knowledge especially in digitization and documentation and report writing is desirable. Age limit 35 years.

Nature of duty :

Category A :

Project Scientist : To supervise and coordinate the implementation of Plan project. Involves in field or laboratory based work depending upon the project. Project Scientist will be reporting to the designated officer of the Survey

Category B :

Project Research Associate : To conduct field work and analysis of the data under the supervision of Category A Officers or Senior Officers of the Survey. Involves extensive field/lab work or both as the case may be.

Project Assistant Librarian : To take care of library works under the supervision of Librarian Or Project Librarian or Designated officer of the Survey.

Category C :

Project Research Assistant : To conduct fieldwork and collect data under the supervision of Senior Officers of the Survey or Project Senior Scientist or Project Research Associate.

Note :

- 1) For each post HRA included in remuneration.
- 2) For practical purposes daily working of eight hours will be considered as 100% Monday to Friday except holiday is working days in Head Quarters, but on tour every day is working day.
- 3) Age and educational qualification may also be relaxed in exceptional cases by the Head of the Department.

Tenure of the post under contractual appointment :

The tenure will be initially till 31.03.2012 which may be extended subject to satisfaction of the work assigned to the personnel and approval of the Competent Authority.

All the basic data collected by the Research Personnel on contract shall be the property of Anthropological Survey of India. The Research personnel on contract will have no right over the data collected by him/her.

Facilities :

The Research Personnel on contract will be provided with all infrastructure facilities available in the Survey to facilitate the Research work.

TA/OA for the cadres on Tour/Transfer:

TA (Travelling Expenses)/OA(Accommodation and Boarding) of the Category A Research Personnel will be given at per the Group A Officer. Category B & C will be at par with Group B Gazetted Officer and Group B Non-Gazetted Officer respectively of Govt. of India established norms and procedure. The candidates those who are attending interview from outside will be paid Slipper Class Train fare for both ways of journey.

Leave :

30 days leave in a year is admissible for each category of the post which will be granted by the head of Office. The women candidates will however be eligible for maternity leave with remuneration for a period not exceeding 3 months during the tenure.

Interested candidates may come for interview along with an application on plain paper as per prescribed format, addressed to the Director, Anthropological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, 27, Jawaharlal Nehru Road, Kolkata – 700 016. Only self attested copies of degrees, diplomas and testimonials may be attached with the application. Original copies should be produced at the time of interview. Two copies of recent self attested passport size photographs of the applicant (one pasted on the application) must be submitted. A character certificate from a Gazetted Officer or a Member of Parliament or a Member of Legislative Assemble or Principal or Head of the Department of the Institute of candidate attended last or a well known person of the locality where the candidate is residing should also accompany the application.
