Eligibility:

Educational Qualification:

Project Research Associate: Masters Degree in Anthropological or Allied Disciplines with desirable supporting Ph.D. or three years experience as evidence of contribution in Anthropology, Fieldwork experience is desirable.

Project Research Assistant: Masters Degree in Anthropological or Allied Disciplines, preference will be given to the candidates having fieldwork experience. Computer Knowledge especially in digitalization and documentation and report writing is desirable.

Age:

Project Research Associate: Not exceeding 40 years as on date of Interview.

Project Research Assistant: Not exceeding 35 years as on date of Interview.

Consolidated Remuneration:

Project Research Associate: Rs. 15,000/- per month (consolidated)

Project Research Assistant: Rs. 8,000/- per month (consolidated)
