RECRUITMENT OF SENIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS THROUGH WALK-IN-INTERVIEW

Anthropological Survey of India, North West Regional Centre, Dehradun keeping in view to accomplish research studies in the Plan Project entitled DNA Polymorphism of Contemporary Indian Populations and Ancient Skeletal Materials, invites application along with curriculum vitae from suitable candidates for recruitment of Senior Research Fellowship through Walk-in-Interview to be held on 21st November, 2011 at the office of Head of Office, Anthropological Survey of India, North West Regional Centre, 192/1, Kaulagarh Road, Dehradun.

Format of application form and other details are as follows:-

1. Purpose of the Fellowship:

To provide opportunity to research students/scholars to undertake advance study and research in Anthropology and allied disciplines related to Bio-Cultural Sciences.

2. Vacancy – Senior Research Fellow – 2 (two)

3. Stipend Rates:

Senior Research Fellow - ₹12,000/- P.M. (Consolidated)

4. Annual Contingency Rates:

Senior Research Fellow - ₹12,000/- P.A. (Payable on quarterly basis)

5. Eligibility:

- (a) Senior Research Fellowship is open to persons below the age of 32 years with at least 55% marks in Master's Degree in Anthropology/Allied Disciplines related to Bio-Cultural Sciences of any recognized University/Institute with at least two years research experience having published work of a good standard.
- (b) In exceptional cases the Secretary (Culture) can offer any fellowship to any scholar without fulfilling required formalities.
- (c) Age and educational qualifications may also be relaxed in exceptional cases.

Note:

- i) Senior Research Fellows will work on the Plan projects launched by the Anthropological Survey of India or any other project approved by the Director/Head of the Department.
- ii) The same Fellowship will not be awarded twice to a person.
- iii) Fellows will be attached to the Anthropological Survey of India, North West Regional Centre, Dehradun

6. Selection process:

Senior Fellows will be selected through written test followed by Interview.

7. Tenure of Fellowship:

The tenure of Fellowships will be for three years. However, in deserving cases the period can be extended for one more year by the Director/Head of the Department on the recommendation of the committee so constituted by the competent authority in each case.

8. Application for Senior Fellowship:

Interested candidates may come for interview along with an application on plane paper, addressed to the Director, Anthropological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, 27, Jawaharlal Nehru Road, Kolkata-700016 and a crossed Indian Postal Order of (₹25/- in case of ST & SC candidates) in favour of the Pay & Accounts Officer, Pay and Accounts Office, Department of Culture, Kolkata payable at GPO, Kolkata. Only self attested copies of degrees, diplomas and testimonials may be attached with the application. Original copies should be produced at the time of interview. Two copies of recent self attested passport photographs of the applicant (one pasted on the application) must be submitted. A character certificate from a Gazetted Officer or a Member of Parliament or a Member of Legislative Assembly or Principal or Head of the Department of the Institute the candidate attended last or a well known person of the locality where the candidate is residing should be accompany the application.

All the candidates are entitled to draw Travelling allowances traveled by sleeper class (shortest route) and by Government Bus for attending the interview on submission of tickets for their onward journey. No private bus fare will be entertained.

The Fellowship shall be awarded on the basis of merit on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
